ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON HIP WO STREET, YUET WAH STREET AND MUT WAH STREET. KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 22 September 2023, the following road sections in Kwun Tong will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Hip Wo Street from its southern junction with Yuet Wah Street to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Hip Wo Street from its southern junction with Yuet Wah Street to a point about 115 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Hip Wo Street from a point about 20 metres south of its junction with Mut Wah Street to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the section of Yuet Wah Street from its southern junction with Hip Wo Street to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction; and
- (e) the northern kerbside lane of Mut Wah Street from its junction with Hip Wo Street to a point about 35 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
