- 3. For the said building works in paragraph 1 above:
  - As a result of item (i) above, Regulation 30(1)(a) of the Building (Standards of Sanitary Fitments, Plumbing, Drainage Works and Latrines) Regulations, which requires that when more than one trap of a watercloset fitment is connected with one soil pipe, the traps shall be ventilated by means of anti-syphonage pipes, has been contravened.
