

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON LOK YIP ROAD AND ON KUI STREET, FANLING

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 6 October 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of On Kui Street from its junction with Lok Yip Road to a point about 12 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Lok Yip Road from its junction with On Kui Street to a point about 14 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of On Kui Street from its junction with Lok Yip Road to a point about 12 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Lok Yip Road from its junction with On Kui Street to a point about 13 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
