

PROTECTION OF WAGES ON INSOLVENCY ORDINANCE (Chapter 380)

(Notice of payment and reasons therefore
given pursuant to section 16(1A))

Notice is given pursuant to section 16(1A) of the Protection of Wages on Insolvency Ordinance (Chapter 380) that I have made an *ex gratia* payment of \$9,231.77 out of the Protection of Wages on Insolvency Fund under section 16(1)(a)(ii) of that Ordinance to CHIU Wai Chung and TSANG Chi Keung ('the Employee(s)'), the former employee(s) of NGAN Hon Tuen trading as 添仔蝦餃 ('the Employer') of Shop CF12, Luen Wo Hui Market Cooked Food Centre, 9 Wo Mun Street, Luen Wo Hui, Fanling, New Territories and Flat 1502, 15/F, Luk Yat House, Yat Tung (I) Estate, 8 Yat Tung Street, Tung Chung, Lantau Island, New Territories, the reasons for the payment being that it appeared to me that the Employer had failed to pay wages, or pay for untaken annual leave, or pay for untaken statutory holidays, or wages in lieu of notice, or severance payment, or all or any of them due to the Employee(s) and would, but for the existence of section 6(2)(a) of the Bankruptcy Ordinance (Chapter 6), be liable to have a bankruptcy petition presented against him.
