ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON KAK TIN STREET, TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 29 September 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Kak Tin Street from its junction with Chui Tin Street to a point about 75 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Kak Tin Street from its junction with Chui Tin Street to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Kak Tin Street from its junction with the access road to Golden Lion Garden to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Chui Tin Street from a point about 5 metres east of its junction with Kak Tin Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction; and
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of the access road to Golden Lion Garden from its junction with Kak Tin Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or road markings.
