ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON NG LAU ROAD, TUEN MUN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 29 September 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Tsing Chuen Wai Road northbound from its western junction with Ng Lau Road to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Ng Lau Road from a point about 15 metres east of its western junction with Tsing Chuen Wai Road northbound to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the section of unnamed access road leading to Fortress Villa from its junction with Ng Lau Road to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Ng Lau Road from a point about 10 metres east of its junction with unnamed access road leading to Fortress Villa to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction;
- (e) the section of Tsing Chuen Wai Road southbound from its eastern junction with Ng Lau Road to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction; and
- (f) the section of Ng Lau Road from a point about 20 metres east of its eastern junction with Tsing Chuen Wai Road southbound to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
