ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON PAK WO ROAD AND THE UNNAMED ACCESS ROAD LEADING TO PAK WO ROAD CAR PARK (OPEN), FANLING

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 3 February 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Pak Wo Road from its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Pak Wo Road Car Park (open) (near Fung Ying Seen Koon) to a point about 11 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of the unnamed access road leading to Pak Wo Road Car Park (open) (near Fung Ying Seen Koon) from its junction with Pak Wo Road to a point about 8 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of the unnamed access road leading to Pak Wo Road Car Park (open) (near Fung Ying Seen Koon) from its junction with Pak Wo Road to a point about 16 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
