ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN PEI HO STREET AND YU CHAU STREET, SHAM SHUI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 29 January 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Pei Ho Street from a point about 6 metres south of its junction with Yu Chau Street to a point about 8 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Yu Chau Street from its junction with Pei Ho Street to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Yu Chau Street from its junction with Pei Ho Street to a point about 16 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
