ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON LAI KING HILL ROAD, KWAI CHUNG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that the following road sections in Kwai Chung will be temporarily designated as restricted zones during the following periods:—

(I) From 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. daily from 2 February 2023 to 3 February 2023 and from 10.00 a.m. on 4 February 2023 to 6.00 a.m. on 6 February 2023

The eastern kerbside lane of Lai King Hill Road (excluding the layby) from a point about 80 metres north of its junction with King Lai Path to a point about 137 metres north of the same junction.

- (II) From 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. daily from 6 February 2023 to 8 February 2023
 - (a) The eastern kerbside lane of Lai King Hill Road (including the layby) from a point about 80 metres north of its junction with King Lai Path to a point about 137 metres north of the same junction; and
 - (b) The western kerbside lane of Lai King Hill Road from a point about 80 metres north of its junction with King Lai Path to a point about 150 metres north of the same junction.
- (III) From 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. daily from 9 February 2023 to 18 February 2023
 - (a) The western kerbside lane of Lai King Hill Road from a point about 125 metres north of its junction with King Lai Path to a point about 150 metres north of the same junction; and
 - (b) The western kerbside lane of Lai King Hill Road (excluding the layby) from a point about 80 metres north of its junction with King Lai Path to a point about 125 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or road markings.
