ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT AT FANLING HIGHWAY AND HEUNG YUEN WAI HIGHWAY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 11.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m. of the following day daily on every Monday and Thursday during the period from 10 October 2022 to 6 April 2023, the following road sections will be subject to a temporary speed limit of 70 kilometres per hour:—

- (a) the section of Fanling Highway southbound from a point about 300 metres south of Tai Wo Service Road East roundabout to a point about 25 metres south of Kau Lung Hang Vehicular Bridge; and
- (b) the section of Heung Yuen Wai Highway southbound from its junction with Fanling Highway southbound to a point about 250 metres north of the same junction.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists.

At the same time, the existing speed limit on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
