ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TAM KON SHAN ROAD, TSING YI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 7 October 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Tam Kon Shan Road from a point about 62 metres north of its junction with Tam Kon Shan Interchange to a point about 125 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Tam Kon Shan Road from a point about 78 metres north of its junction with Tam Kon Shan Interchange to a point about 106 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Tam Kon Shan Road from a point about 112 metres north of its junction with Tam Kon Shan Interchange to a point about 128 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Tam Kon Shan Road from a point about 141 metres north of its junction with Tam Kon Shan Interchange to a point about 191 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
