ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON PING LAN STREET, AP LEI CHAU

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 11 October 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zone 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Ping Lan Street from a point about 5 metres south of its junction with Main Street, Ap Lei Chau to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Ping Lan Street from a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Main Street, Ap Lei Chau to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses, and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily on the western kerbside lane of Ping Lan Street from a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Main Street, Ap Lei Chau to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction will be rescinded.
