(Notice under section 23)**

**TUEN MUN SOUTH EXTENSION**

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RAMPS AND STAIRCASES OF  
FOOTBRIDGES ACROSS TUEN MUN RIVER CHANNEL IN YAU OI ESTATE  
AND NEAR TUEN YEE STREET, TUEN YEE STREET AND ITS ADJACENT  
FOOTPATH, SAN HOP LANE AND ITS ADJACENT OPEN SPACE, SLIP ROADS  
FROM WONG CHU ROAD TO HOI WONG ROAD, AND AN ACCESS ROAD  
CONNECTING PUI TO ROAD AND TUEN MUN PARK AND ITS ADJACENT  
OPEN SPACE; AND SECTIONS OF PUI TO ROAD, TIN HAU ROAD AND ITS  
SLIP ROADS, WONG CHU ROAD, HOI WONG ROAD AND ITS ADJACENT  
ROADS, HOI CHU ROAD, HING ON LANE, AND  
ROAD ON THE EASTERN SIDE OF TUEN MUN RIVER CHANNEL**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Logistics has, by order made on 28 September 2023 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary partial closure of the ramp and staircase of the footbridge across Tuen Mun River Channel in Yau Oi Estate, as delineated and shown in dark purple on the Plan numbered TMSE/G03/0003/1;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the ramp and staircase of the footbridge across Tuen Mun River Channel near Tuen Yee Street, as delineated and shown in dark green on the Plan numbered TMSE/G04/0003/1;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of Tuen Yee Street and its adjacent footpath, as delineated and shown in olive on the Plan numbered TMSE/G04/0003/1;
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of San Hop Lane and its adjacent open space, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered TMSE/G02/0003/1;
- (V) the temporary partial closure of the slip roads from Wong Chu Road to Hoi Wong Road, as delineated and shown in brown on the Plans numbered TMSE/G03/0003/1 and TMSE/G04/0003/1;
- (VI) the temporary partial closure of the access road connecting Pui To Road and Tuen Mun Park and its adjacent open space, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered TMSE/G02/0003/1;
- (VII) the temporary partial closure of the section of Pui To Road between a point about 90 metres southeast of its junction with Tin Hau Road and a point about

230 metres southeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered TMSE/G02/0003/1;

- (VIII) the temporary partial closure of the section of Tin Hau Road between a point about 140 metres southwest of its junction with Pui To Road and a point about 10 metres east of its junction with Yip Wong Road, and its slip roads, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plans numbered TMSE/G02/0003/1 and TMSE/G03/0003/1;
- (IX) the temporary partial closure of the section of Wong Chu Road across Tuen Mun River Channel and near Tuen Mun River (Eastern Bank) Garden, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plans numbered TMSE/G03/0003/1 and TMSE/G04/0003/1;
- (X) the temporary partial closure of the sections of Hoi Wong Road between its junction with Wong Chu Road and a point about 135 metres south of its junction with Tuen Yee Street, between its junction with Wu Shan Road and a point about 300 metres northeast of the junction, and its adjacent roads, as delineated and shown in dark blue on the Plans numbered TMSE/G03/0003/1, TMSE/G04/0003/1 and TMSE/G05/0003/1;
- (XI) the temporary partial closure of the section of Hoi Chu Road between its junction with Hoi Wong Road and a point about 135 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in light purple on the Plan numbered TMSE/G04/0003/1;
- (XII) the temporary partial closure of the section of Hing On Lane between its junction with Hoi Chu Road and a point about 10 metres north of the junction, as delineated and shown in grey on the Plan numbered TMSE/G04/0003/1; and
- (XIII) the temporary partial closure of the section of the road on the eastern side of Tuen Mun River Channel, as delineated and shown in light blue on the Plans numbered TMSE/G03/0003/1, TMSE/G04/0003/1 and TMSE/G05/0003/1,

during the period from 20 October 2023 to 19 October 2024 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Tuen Mun South Extension. A description of the works to be carried out, the footbridge ramps and staircases, the roads, the footpath, the open space and the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered TMSE/G02/0003/1, TMSE/G03/0003/1, TMSE/G04/0003/1 and TMSE/G05/0003/1 (the 'Plans') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the footbridge ramps and staircases, the roads, the footpath and the open space affected by the Order on 6 October 2023.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Logistics so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Logistics before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the footbridge ramps and staircases, the roads, the footpath and the open space or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the footbridge ramps and staircases, the roads, the footpath and the open space affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means:–

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the footbridge ramps and staircases, the roads, the footpath and the open space or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.
