

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

TUEN MUN SOUTH EXTENSION

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
THE WORKS OVER AND UPON THE GOVERNMENT FORESHORE AND
SEA-BED AT TUEN MUN TYPHOON SHELTER OFF WU SHAN ROAD AND
AT TUEN MUN RIVER CHANNEL**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Logistics has, by order made on 28 September 2023 (the ‘Order’), authorized:–

- (I) the works over and upon the Government foreshore and sea-bed at Tuen Mun Typhoon Shelter off Wu Shan Road, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered TMSE/G07/0001/1 during the period from 20 October 2023 to 30 June 2028; and
- (II) the works over and upon the Government foreshore and sea-bed at Tuen Mun River Channel, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plans numbered TMSE/G02/0001/1, TMSE/G03/0001/1, TMSE/G04/0001/1 and TMSE/G05/0001/1 during the period from 20 October 2023 to 31 July 2030,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Tuen Mun South Extension. A description of the works to be carried out, the areas of the Government foreshore and sea-bed to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered TMSE/G07/0001/1, TMSE/G02/0001/1, TMSE/G03/0001/1, TMSE/G04/0001/1 and TMSE/G05/0001/1 (the ‘Plans’) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:–

A copy of this notice will be affixed near the Government foreshore and sea-bed affected by the Order on 6 October 2023.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Logistics so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Logistics before the expiration of one year from the works over and upon the relevant part or parts of the Government foreshore and sea-bed or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the Government foreshore and sea-bed affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means:–

- (1) by post or by hand to the Transport and Logistics Bureau's Drop-in Box No. 6 located at the 2nd Floor Entrance, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong. The box is available for use between 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday (except public holidays);

Notice is hereby given that further works over and upon the same part or parts of the Government foreshore and sea-bed or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for works will be published if and when such an order is made.
