ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN TSIM SHA TSUL

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 17 October 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 9 April 2023, the following road sections will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Carnarvon Road from a point about 30 metres north of its junction with Cameron Road to a point about 40 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Cameron Road from a point about 60 metres west of its junction with Carnarvon Road to a point about 40 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
