ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN WAN CHAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 14 October 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of the unnamed road connecting Convention Avenue and Lung Wo Road:
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Lung Wo Road from its junction with the unnamed road connecting Convention Avenue and Lung Wo Road to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Convention Avenue from its junction with the unnamed road connecting Convention Avenue and Lung Wo Road to a point about 90 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Convention Avenue from a point about 100 metres west of its junction with the unnamed road connecting Convention Avenue and Lung Wo Road to a point about 155 metres west of the same junction; and
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Convention Avenue from its junction with the unnamed road connecting Convention Avenue and Lung Wo Road to a point about 165 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
