ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 14 October 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from a point about 30 metres east of its eastern junction with Lam Tsuen Heung Kung Sho Road to a point about 25 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Lam Tsuen Heung Kung Sho Road from its eastern junction with Lam Kam Road to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from a point about 25 metres east of its western junction with Lam Tsuen Heung Kung Sho Road to a point about 35 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road (including the lay-by) from a point about 10 metres west of its western junction with Lam Tsuen Heung Kung Sho Road to a point about 40 metres west of the same junction; and
- (e) the section of Lam Tsuen Heung Kung Sho Road from its western junction with Lam Kam Road to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
