

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

PROHIBITED ZONE FOR VEHICLES EXCEEDING 8 METRES IN LENGTH
AT POK CHUEN STREET, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 October 2022, the section of Pok Chuen Street from its *cul-de-sac* to a point about 60 metres north of the same *cul-de-sac* will be designated as prohibited zone 24 hours daily for vehicles exceeding 8 metres in length.

Drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from driving any vehicles exceeding 8 metres in length into the prohibited zone.

The extent of the prohibited zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs.

At the same time, the existing prohibited zone for vehicles exceeding 8 metres in length on the section of Pok Chuen Street from a point about 60 metres north of its *cul-de-sac* to a point about 390 metres north of the same *cul-de-sac* will be rescinded.
