

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON LOK SHAN ROAD AND PAU CHUNG STREET,  
TO KWA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 22 October 2022, the following road sections in To Kwa Wan will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Lok Shan Road from a point about 20 metres west of its junction with Kowloon City Road to a point about 60 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Pau Chung Street from its junction with Lok Shan Road to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
