ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON LAM KAM ROAD, TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 October 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Lam Kam Road (including the lay-by) from a point about 215 metres north of its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 255 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from a point about 310 metres north of its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 350 metres north of the same junction; and
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from a point about 320 metres north of its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 350 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
