ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON CHA KWO LING ROAD AND WAI YIP STREET, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 28 October 2022, the following road sections in Kwun Tong will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Cha Kwo Ling Road from a point about 155 metres south of its junction with Wai Yip Street to a point about 190 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Cha Kwo Ling Road from a point about 195 metres south of its junction with Wai Yip Street to a point about 335 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Cha Kwo Ling Road from a point about 140 metres south of its junction with Wai Yip Street to a point about 185 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Cha Kwo Ling Road from a point about 195 metres south of its junction with Wai Yip Street to a point about 385 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the section of unnamed road 190 metres south of the junction of Cha Kwo Ling Road and Wai Yip Street from its junction with Cha Kwo Ling Road to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction;
- (f) the eastern kerbside lane of Wai Yip Street from a point about 150 metres north of its junction with Wai Lok Street to a point about 85 metres south of the same junction; and
- (g) the western kerbside lane of Wai Yip Street from a point about 15 metres north of its junction with Wai Lok Street to a point about 150 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
