

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONE ON TAM KUNG ROAD,
TO KWA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.01 p.m. on 29 October 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 15 April 2023, the section of Tam Kung Road from a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Sung Wong Toi Road to a point about 55 metres south of the same junction will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zone 24 hours daily.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
