ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON WING LUNG STREET AND FUK WING STREET, CHEUNG SHA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 1 November 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Wing Lung Street from its junction with Fuk Wing Street to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street from its junction with Wing Lung Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street from its junction with Wing Lung Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street from its junction with Tonkin Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction; and
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street from its junction with Tonkin Street to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
