ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON ON SUM STREET AND ON LAI STREET AT SHEK MUN. SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 28 October 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of On Sum Street northbound from a point about 40 metres south of its junction with On Lai Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of On Sum Street southbound from a point about 45 metres north of its junction with On Lai Street to the same junction;
- (c) the section of On Lai Street westbound from its junction with On Sum Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of On Lai Street eastbound from a point about 45 metres west of its junction with On Sum Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction; and
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of On Lai Street eastbound from its junction with On Sum Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
