ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 28 October 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from a point about 250 metres west of its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 295 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from a point about 255 metres west of its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 295 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from a point about 220 metres west of its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 225 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the section of the unnamed access road leading to Tong Min Tsuen Playground (about 240 metres west of She Shan Road along Lam Kam Road) from its junction with Lam Kam Road to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction;
- (e) the northern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road (including the lay-by) from a point about 500 metres west of its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 535 metres west of the same junction; and
- (f) the southern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from a point about 500 metres west of its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 540 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
