ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON CHUN YAT STREET AND CHUN CHEONG STREET, TSEUNG KWAN O

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 28 October 2022, the following road sections in Tseung Kwan O will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Chun Yat Street from a point about 35 metres north from its junction with Chun Cheong Street to the northern kerbside lane of a point about 43 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Chun Cheong Street from a point about 35 metres east from its junction with Chun Yat Street to the eastern kerbside lane of a point about 43 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Chun Yat Street from a point about 38 metres south from its junction with Chun Cheong Street to the southern kerbside lane of a point about 43 metres west of the same junction; and
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Chun Cheong Street from a point about 38 metres west from its junction with Chun Yat Street to the western kerbside lane of a point about 40 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
