## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON SUNG YIN LANE AND YAT SIN STREET, WAN CHAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 9.00 a.m. on 27 October 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Sung Yin Lane from its junction with Yat Sin Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Sung Yin Lane from its junction with Yat Sin Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the westhern kerbside lane of Yat Sin Street from its junction with Sung Yin Lane to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the westhern kerbside lane of Yat Sin Street from its junction with Sung Yin Lane to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction; and
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Yat Sin Street from a point about 35 metres north of its junction with Lap Tak Lane to a point about 55 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
