ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN HUNG HOM

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 30 October 2023 to 6.00 p.m. on 4 November 2023, the following road sections in Hung Hom will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Pak Kung Street between Ko Shan Road and Chatham Road North;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Ko Shan Road southbound from its junction with Pak Kung Street eastbound to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Shun Yung Street southbound from its junction with Pak Kung Street westbound to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Chatham Road North northbound from its junction with Pak Kung Street eastbound to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of Chatham Road North northbound from its junction with Pak Kung Street westbound to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
