ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONE ON TSUI PING ROAD, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 4 November 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Tsui Ping Road from its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Tsui Ping (South) Estate to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Tsui Ping Road from its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Tsui Ping (South) Estate to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Tsui Ping Road from its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Tsui Ping (South) Estate to a point about 40 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Tsui Ping Road from its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Tsui Ping (South) Estate to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
