ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON MA TAU KOK ROAD AND LUNG TO STREET. TO KWA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 7 November 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 3 December 2022, the following road sections will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Ma Tau Kok Road from a point about 10 metres east of its junction with Kowloon City Road to a point about 60 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Ma Tau Kok Road from its junction with Lung To Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Lung To Street from its junction with Ma Tau Kok Road to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Ma Tau Kok Road from its junction with Fung Yi Street to a point about 25 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
