

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON WO TONG TSUI STREET
AND KWONG FAI CIRCUIT, KWAI CHUNG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.01 p.m. on 4 November 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 25 November 2022, the following road sections in Kwai Chung will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Wo Tong Tsui Street from its junction with Wo Kwai Lane to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Kwong Fai Circuit from a point about 6 metres west of its junction with Wo Tong Tsui Street to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Wo Tong Tsui Street from its junction with Kwong Fai Circuit to a point about 54 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Kwong Fai Circuit from its junction with Wo Tong Tsui Street to a point about 21 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner of Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
