## FIRE SERVICES ORDINANCE (Chapter 95)

## ORDER MADE BY THE REGISTERED FIRE SERVICE INSTALLATION CONTRACTORS DISCIPLINARY BOARD

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Board appointed by the Chief Executive under regulation 9 of the Fire Service (Installation Contractors) Regulations (the 'Regulations'), subsidiary legislation of the Fire Services Ordinance, Chapter 95, Laws of Hong Kong, was satisfied after a due inquiry held on 22 September 2022 in accordance with regulation 10 of the Regulations, that Firetech Services Limited, being a Class 1 and Class 2 registered Fire Service Installation Contractor, was guilty of improper conduct or negligence in the installation, maintenance, repair or inspection of fire service installation or equipment at the premises at World Trade Centre, 280 Gloucester Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong, (i) before the commencement of shutdown of fire service installations for work, i.e. before 14 October 2020, 3 November 2020 and 16 December 2020, did fail to notify the Fire Services Department at least 7 calendar days prior to the commencement of work; (ii) before the previous estimated date of completion, i.e. before 21 September 2021, did fail to submit a written notification of extension to the Fire Services Department in respect of extensions of shutdown of fire service installations; and (iii) on 15 December 2021, did fail to post at prominent locations simple and standardized graphical notices of size not smaller than A4 size detailing the shutdown of fire service installations, such that the contractor is unfit to be on the register of fire service installation contractors.

It is further notified that pursuant to regulation 10(2)(a) of the Regulations, the said Disciplinary Board ordered that the name of Firetech Services Limited be removed from the register of fire service installation contractors in Class 1 and Class 2 for the respective period of 6 weeks, 6 weeks and 2 weeks running concurrently, which order will take effect from 25 October 2022 to 5 December 2022.
