

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 Sub. Leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON PAK WO ROAD AND KAT CHEUNG CRESCENT,
FANLING

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 12 November 2021, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of northern kerbside lane of Pak Wo Road from a point about 15 metres west of its junction with Kat Cheung Crescent (near Vienna Garden) to a point about 2 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the section of western kerbside lane of Kat Cheung Crescent (near Vienna Garden) from its junction with Pak Wo Road to a point about 47 metres north of the same junction; and
- (c) the section of eastern kerbside lane of Kat Cheung Crescent (near Vienna Garden) from its junction with Pak Wo Road to a point about 44 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily on part of the above road sections will be rescinded.
