

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN KA SHIN STREET AND KOK CHEUNG STREET,
TAI KOK TSUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 19 November 2021, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Ka Shin Street from its junction with Kok Cheung Street to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Kok Cheung Street from its junction with Ka Shin Street to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Kok Cheung Street from its junction with Ka Shin Street to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
