**United Nations Sanctions (Mali) Regulation 2019
(Amendment) Regulation 2021**

(Made by the Chief Executive under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537) on the instruction of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China and after consultation with the Executive Council)

1. United Nations Sanctions (Mali) Regulation 2019 amended

The United Nations Sanctions (Mali) Regulation 2019 (Cap. 537 sub. leg. CL) is amended as set out in section 2.

2. Section 2 amended (limited duration of certain provisions)

(1) Section 2(3), after “2020”—

Add

“(L.N. 217 of 2020)”.

(2) After section 2(3)—

Add

“(4) Sections 3, 4 and 5 are in force during the period from the commencement of the United Nations Sanctions (Mali) Regulation 2019 (Amendment) Regulation 2021 until midnight on 31 August 2022.”.

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the United Nations Sanctions (Mali) Regulation 2019 (Cap. 537 sub. leg. CL) (*principal Regulation*) to give effect to certain decisions in Resolution 2590 (2021) adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 30 August 2021.

2. Section 2(2) of this Regulation amends section 2 of the principal Regulation to provide that sections 3, 4 and 5 of the principal Regulation (*relevant provisions*) are in force until midnight on 31 August 2022.
3. The relevant provisions relate to the prohibition against—
 - (a) making available to, or for the benefit of, certain persons or entities any funds or other financial assets or economic resources;
 - (b) dealing with funds or other financial assets or economic resources belonging to, or owned or controlled by, certain persons or entities; and
 - (c) entry into or transit through the HKSAR by certain persons.
