

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITED ZONE FOR VEHICLES EXCEEDING  
10 METRES IN LENGTH ON SIN FAT ROAD, LAM TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 30 November 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 31 January 2023, the section of Sin Fat Road from a point about 540 metres east of its junction with Cha Kwo Ling Road to its *cul-de-sec* will be temporarily designated as a prohibited zone for all motor vehicles exceeding 10 metres in length 24 hours daily.

Drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from driving vehicles exceeding 10 metres in length into the prohibited zone.

The extent of the prohibited zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs.
