

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON FANLING STATION ROAD, FANLING

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 29 November 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Fanling Station Road from a point about 13 metres south of its junction with the unnamed access road leading to the exit of the carpark of Fanling Town Centre to a point about 55 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Fanling Station Road from a point about 13 metres south of its junction with the unnamed access road leading to the exit of the carpark of Fanling Town Centre to a point about 28 metres north of the same junction; and
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Fanling Station Road from a point about 45 metres north of its junction with the unnamed access road leading to the exit of the carpark of Fanling Town Centre to a point about 55 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
