TELECOMMUNICATIONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 106)

Pursuant to sections 7B(3)(a) and 7C(4) of the Telecommunications Ordinance, the Communications Authority ('CA') publishes today a consultation paper entitled 'Creation of a Class Licence for Regulating the Use of and Trade in 6 GHz Devices for Wireless Local Area Network and Variation to the Class Licence for Provision of Public Wireless Local Area Network Services' proposing to:—

- (a) create a class licence to regulate the possession, use and trading of wireless local area network ('WLAN') devices operating in the 5925–6425 MHz band; and
- (b) vary the Class Licence for Provision of Public Wireless Local Area Network Services to allow the use of the 5925–6425 MHz band for provision of public WLAN services.
