ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN SHAM SHULPO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 am on 26 November 2021, the following road sections in Sham Shui Po will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street from its junction with Pratas Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Pratas Street from its junction with Fuk Wing Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street between Pratas Street and Camp Street (except metered parking spaces);
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Fuk Wing Street from its junction with Camp Street to a point about 90 metres west of the same junction (except metered parking spaces);
- (e) the western kerbside lane of Camp Street from its junction with Fuk Wing Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction;
- (f) the western kerbside lane of Camp Street from its junction with Fuk Wing Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction; and
- (g) the eastern kerbside lane of Camp Street from its junction with Fuk Wing Street to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
