## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 30 November 2021, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of On Yiu Street eastbound from a point about 50 metres west of its junction with On Kwan Street to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of On Yiu Street eastbound from a point about 30 metres east of its junction with On Kwan Street to a point about 60 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of On Yiu Street westbound from a point about 20 metres west of its junction with On Kwan Street to a point about 120 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of On Kwan Street southbound from its junction with On Yiu Street to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of On Kwan Street northbound from a point about 50 metres south of its junction with On Yiu Street to the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
