ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN LARCH STREET, WALNUT STREET AND FUK TSUN STREET. TAI KOK TSUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 26 November 2021, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Larch Street from its junction with Walnut Street to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Larch Street from its junction with Walnut Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the section of Walnut Street from its junction with Larch Street to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Walnut Street from its junction with Larch Street to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction;
- (e) the section of Walnut Street from its junction with Fuk Tsun Street to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction;
- (f) the northern kerbside lane of Fuk Tsun Street from its junction with Walnut Street to a point about 15 metre west of the same junction; and
- (g) the southern kerbside lane of Fuk Tsun Street from a point about 35 metres east of its junction with Walnut Street to a point about 55 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
