CHINESE MEDICINE ORDINANCE (Chapter 549)

ORDER MADE BY THE CHINESE MEDICINE PRACTITIONERS BOARD OF THE CHINESE MEDICINE COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

Notice is hereby given that the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board of the Chinese Medicine Council of Hong Kong, after inquiry on 25 October 2022 conducted pursuant to section 98(2) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Chapter 549, Laws of Hong Kong), was satisfied that the following charge of professional misconduct against TSE Fook-cheong, registered Chinese medicine practitioner (registration no.: 001283), is proved:—

he was convicted at the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Kwun Tong Magistrates' Courts on 17 August 2021 of two offences, namely, 'conspiracy to defraud', contrary to Common Law and punishable under section 159C of the Crimes Ordinance, Chapter 200, Laws of Hong Kong, and hence breached section 98(2)(a) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance for having been convicted in Hong Kong of an offence punishable with imprisonment.

Pursuant to section 98(3) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board ordered on 25 October 2022 that for the above established charge, the name of TSE Fook-cheong be removed from the Register of Chinese Medicine Practitioners for 12 months, with effect from 2 December 2022.

In accordance with section 104 of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, the above order made by the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board of the Chinese Medicine Council of Hong Kong is hereby published.
