

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITED ZONE FOR VEHICLES EXCEEDING 8 METRES
IN LENGTH IN TAI WO INTERCHANGE, KWAI CHUNG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 16 December 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 22 February 2023, the section of Tai Wo Interchange (Northbound) between Wah King Hill Road (Northbound) and Castle Peak Road—Kwai Chung (Southbound) will be temporarily designated as prohibited zone 24 hours daily for vehicles exceeding 8 metres in length.

Drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from driving vehicles exceeding 8 metres in length into the prohibited zone.

The extent of the prohibited zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs.
