ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN HOP YICK ROAD, HOP CHOI STREET AND KIN TAK STREET. YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10 a.m. on 9 December 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Hop Yick Road from its junction with Hop Choi Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Hop Choi Street from its junction with Hop Yick Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction (excluding lay-by);
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Hop Choi Street from its junction with Hop Yick Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Hop Yick Road from its junction with Hop Choi Street to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Hop Yick Road from its junction with Kin Tak Street to a point about 25 metres west of the same junction;
- (f) the western kerbside lane of Kin Tak Street from its junction with Hop Yick Road to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction;
- (g) the southern kerbside lane of Hop Yick Road from its junction with Kin Tak Street to a point about 5 metres east of the same junction; and
- (h) the eastern kerbside lane of Kin Tak Street from its junction with Hop Yick Road to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
