

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 3 December 2021, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Lam Kam Road from its junction with She Shan Road to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of She Shan Road from its junction with Lam Kam Road to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the western kerbside lane of She Shan Road from its junction with Lam Kam Road to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
