ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 3 December 2021, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Tung Tsz Road from its junction with Ting Kok Road to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Ting Kok Road from its junction with Tung Tsz Road to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Ting Kok Road from its junction with Tung Tsz Road to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Ting Kok Road from a point about 50 metres north from its junction with Tung Tsz Road to a point about 70 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
