

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

PROHIBITED ZONES FOR VEHICLES EXCEEDING 4.6 METRES IN HEIGHT  
IN KWUN TONG AND TSEUNG KWAN O

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 11 December 2022, the following road sections in Kwun Tong and Tseung Kwan O will be designated as prohibited zones for vehicles exceeding 4.6 metres in height 24 hours daily:—

- (a) Lam Tin Interchange;
- (b) the section of Tseung Lam Highway westbound from a point about 550 metres east of the Tseung Kwan O entrance of Tseung Kwan O—Lam Tin Tunnel; and
- (c) the section of Tseung Lam Highway southbound from a point about 875 metres south of its junction with Po Yap Road to the slip road leading to Tseung Kwan O—Lam Tin Tunnel.

Drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permit issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from driving any vehicles exceeding 4.6 metres in height into the above prohibited zones.

The extent of the prohibited zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs.
