ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON WAI TUNG ROAD, TUNG CHUNG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 9 December 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Wai Tung Road from a point about 114 metres south of its junction with Tung Chung Waterfront Road to a point about 177 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Wai Tung Road from a point about 133 metres south of its junction with Tung Chung Waterfront Road to a point about 152 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Wai Tung Road from a point about 43 metres north of its junction with Man Tung Road to a point about 62 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Wai Tung Road from a point about 77 metres north of its junction with Man Tung Road to a point about 90 metres north of the same junction.

Within the above restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the above restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above sections of Wai Tung Road as gazetted under items (a), (b), (c) and (d) of G.N. 6778 on 18 October 2007 will be rescinded.
