## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON CHA KWO LING ROAD, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 11 December 2022, the following road sections in Kwun Tong will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of the service road of Cha Kwo Ling Road near Lam Tin Interchange;
- (b) the section of Cha Kwo Ling Road from its junction with Lam Tin Interchange to a point about 50 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the section of Cha Kwo Ling Road from its junction with Lam Tin Interchange to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the section of Cha Kwo Ling Road from its junction with Lam Tin Interchange to a point about 120 metres east of the same junction;
- (e) the northern kerbside lane of the slip road leading from Cha Kwo Ling Road eastbound to Lam Tin Interchange from its junction with Cha Kwo Ling Road to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (f) the northern kerbside lane of the slip road leading from Cha Kwo Ling Road eastbound to Yau Tong Road; and
- (g) the section of the access road leading from Cha Kwo Ling Road eastbound to the facilities of Eastern Harbour Crossing.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
