

## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 16 December 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Che Kung Miu Road from a point about 10 metres north of its junction with the access road to Hin Tin Playground to a point about 40 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Mei Tin Road from a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Tai Po Road—Tai Wai to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Mei Tin Road from a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Tai Po Road—Tai Wai to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Tai Po Road—Tai Wai from its junction with Mei Tin Road to a point about 55 metres east of the same junction;
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Mei Tin Road from a point about 45 metres north of its junction with Heung Fan Liu Street to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction;
- (f) the western kerbside lane of Mei Tin Road from its junction with Heung Fan Liu Street to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (g) the northern kerbside lane of Heung Fan Liu Street from a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Mei Fai Street to a point about 55 metres east of the same junction;
- (h) the southern kerbside lane of Heung Fan Liu Street from a point about 20 metres west of its junction with Mei Fai Street to a point about 45 metres east of the same junction; and
- (i) the section of Mei Fai Street from its junction with Heung Fan Liu Street to a point about 55 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
